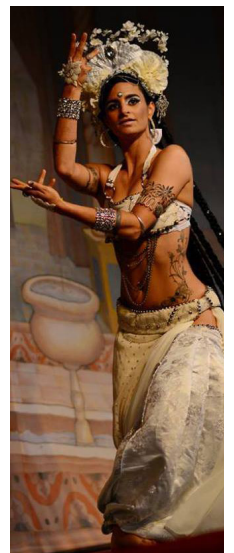
LUNA MOON OF SANTA ROSA, CA AND ACROSS THE GLOBE

Workshop: Pangaea Antiqua - The art of Global Fusion Dance

Pangaea was a supercontinent that existed during the late Paleozoic and early Mesozoic eras. It began to break apart around 100 million years after it formed. In this workshop, Pangaea comes to life again by bringing back together diverse styles of world dance into one class including elements of Balinese, Middle Eastern, Indian, Hip Hop and Sufi dance. From there we will create a unique Global Fusion Dance Choreography. Bring a yoga mat, water bottle be ready to dance your way across the equator!

Luna Moon has studied and performed both nationally and internationally. Her emphasis on dance is in Middle Eastern, Balinese, Indian, Sufi, Fire and many others. Through her choreographies, she combines ancient styles and techniques into diverse, eclectic and abstract forms of performance art through her own creation and vision of "Global Fusion Dance." Luna has shared the stage with some great names in the music industry and performs at major festivals and concerts through out the US. Luna has taught numerous workshops locally and nationwide including most recently at HSU and Santa Rosa Junior College. She is as well a continuing student at the Suhaila Salimpour International School of Belly Dance, while simultaneously attending SRJC majoring in Hip Hop, and Ballet.
